PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS; The City of Nolanville recognizes that the State insect of Texas, the monarch butterfly, is an iconic North American species whose multigenerational migration and metamorphosis from caterpillar to butterfly has captured the imagination of millions of Americans; and

WHEREAS; Both the western and eastern monarch populations have seen significant declines with less than one percent of the western monarch population remaining, while the eastern population has fallen by as much as ninety percent; and

WHEREAS; The City of Nolanville recognizes that human health ultimately depends on well-functioning ecosystems and that biodiverse regions can better support food production, healthy soil and air quality and can foster healthy connections between humans and wildlife; and

WHEREAS; Cities, towns and counties have a critical role to play to help save the monarch butterfly, and The City of Nolanville is striving to become a leader; and


