What is LID?

- LID is a stormwater management strategy that strives to reduce the impact of runoff and stormwater pollution close to its source.

What are the Types of LID Practices?

- Preservation: Technique that is designed and used to minimize runoff and protect natural drainage patterns.
- Restoration: Techniques that uses distributed structural practices to filter, detain, retain, infiltrate, and harvest stormwater.

Why are LID Practices Important?

- LID practices help to remove sediment nutrients, pathogens and metals from runoff, and impacts of stormwater flows.
